

The District will be sending home packets of work with students on Tuesday, March 17th. This work is to cover the next two weeks. The goal is for these packets to keep students engaged with the content and their teacher and not necessarily cover all the gaps in curriculum. Some teachers may also set up work through Google Classroom or other online resources, but we will include paper copies of this work in their packets for those who do not have internet access. Contact information for your child's teacher(s) will be included with this packet. We will also post information for parents on Google Classroom on our website and Facebook. For those students in special services, special education teachers will be available through email concerning modifications to their work. If your child is absent on Tuesday, March 17th, please contact your building for arrangements on getting these assignments to you.

If the closure extends past April 3rd, the district will have materials provided through a link on our website where parents and students can access additional assignments. For those without internet access, we will provide information on how we can get physical copies of these assignments to them.

Our teachers will be very flexible in how we handle these assignments. We hope as a silver lining to this closure, parents will spend time with their child, engaged in their learning. We also will consider this a "pilot" program for alternative methods of instruction in the future. Please have patience with our staff, this is overwhelming and will involve a lot of trial and error.
