

SCHOOLWIDE TITLE 1 PROGRAM PLAN FREDERICKTOWN ELEMENTARY

Overview:

Fredericktown Elementary revised its Title 1 Plan in May of 2020. Eligibility requirements of this program consist of: a) A minimum of 40% of the student population qualifies for Free and Reduced Lunch prices. b) All teachers and paraprofessionals meet the requirements of Highly Qualified educators. c) The eligible school must gather a team of stakeholders to create a schoolwide math and literacy program plan.

Fredericktown Elementary Title 1 Planning and Review Team:

A relevant stakeholder group conducted a needs assessment through a survey and developed a comprehensive plan for the total instructional program for Fredericktown Elementary. The stakeholder group consisted of the Assistant Superintendent, Elementary Principal, Intermediate Principal, 6 Title 1 teachers, 3 Title 1 paraprofessionals, 2 instructional coaches, a teacher representative from each grade level. Parent input was gathered through the use of an online survey due to the pandemic. Although they had met several times throughout the school year, this was the meeting to compound all information.

Benefits of Schoolwide Title 1 Programming:

Schoolwide Title 1 buildings have the ability to utilize their instructional resources in a flexible manner which serves the best interests and needs of our students. Our Reading and Math teachers are able to service any student through our Tier 3 reading and math instructional program. Additionally, our math and reading teachers have the ability to push in classrooms to provide support to students and teachers in the areas of math and reading.

Goals of Schoolwide Title I at Fredericktown Elementary:

1. Implement a systematic response to intervention approach that includes a universal screener, well aligned progress monitoring tools, and research-based interventions that are matched with specific student needs.
2. Continue to build the capacity of teachers through ongoing professional development and by providing opportunities for teachers to work collaboratively in order to strengthen and implement reading and math instruction and interventions with fidelity.

Fredericktown Elementary provides enriched and accelerated curriculum programs to meet the needs of all students. These programs consist of:

District-wide summer school program or Extended School Year Programs, After School Education (Learning Zone), Gifted Education, Project Lead The Way (PLTW), Student Ambassadors, and Positive Behavior Intervention System (PBIS),

Availability of the Complete Plan:

Annually the information contained in the plan is presented to the Fredericktown R-1 School Board, the Title I Advisory Board and the Elementary school staff. Parents are also provided the information at their back to school annual meeting.
