

Snow Routes

Snow routes are bus routes that travel mainly blacktop roads and will be used when blacktop roads are clear enough for safe travel. Parents of children who live on gravel county roads have the option of bringing their child (children) to where the county road meets the blacktop for pick up by the school bus. Parents should also be sure to meet children in the afternoon at the same place where the school bus arrives. The same radio stations and television station that list cancellations will also announce that there will be snow routes run that morning.

Bus #26 Sharon Holtkamp, Black Mountain Route

First pick up at Boushie's Sawmill at 7:10 A.M. for riders on County Rd. 513, back to E to 511 and E intersection pickup, all the way on E back to town; Primary School, High School, Middle School, Intermediate School

Bus #44 Alan Martin, Higdon Run

J Hwy. to NN Hwy.; to County Rd. 257 to County Rd. 252 (Turn around pick up point); back to J to County Rd. 221; 221 to 219 (Turn around pick up point at Twin Oaks); back to 221; stop at 221 and 228 (Pickup); to J Hwy.; to Hwy. 72 East; to High School, Middle School, Intermediate School, and Primary School

Bus #21 Carla Davis, Cornwall Run

Begins at 7:00 A.M. at Hwy. 72 east and F; F to V Hwy.; to County Rd. 244 (Turn around); head back to F Hwy. To 72 East; Turn east on 72 and pick up at County Rd. 247 and 72 intersection; To Frank's Station; Turn around and head back west on 72 toward Fredericktown with pick ups at County Rd. intersections

Van #27 Deborah Sanders, Saco Run

Begin at 7:00 A.M.; C and 445; C and 418; to N Hwy and 443; to 67 N; to town, Middle School, Elementary School, High School, Middle School, Intermediate School

Bus #18 Larry Wojtczuk, Hwy. 72 West Route

Begins at 6:45 A.M. at K Hwy. and County Rd. 529; continue on K, stop at K and County Rd. 512, continue on K to Hwy. 72; go west to bridge (Turn around); East on 72; to County Rd. 504; stop at County Rd. 523 and 504; to Hwy. 72 West, to Middle School, Elementary School, High School, Middle School, Intermediate School

Bus #23 Yvonne Johnson, Perry Co. and J Hwy.

First pick up at 7:00 A.M. at J Hwy. and Perry County Rd. 732 intersection; Back to J, down County Rd. 250 (Orchard Crest), Back to J; to Intermediate School, High School, Middle School, Primary School

Bus #16 Sandy Mayfield, Cornwall/White Springs

Begins at 7:05 A.M. along County Rd. 203; to 203; to 229 (Pickup); head back on 229 to 234 and 229 intersection; Pickup and head to Z Hwy. to Chamber Drive; to High School, Middle School, Intermediate School, Primary School

Bus #12 Jerrod Tune, Killianville Route

Begins at 7:05 A.M. at W and Co. Rd. 208 (Pickup and turn around); head up W to J; J toward 72 with regular pickups; 72 East to 208; turn right (South) on 208 and stop (Pickup point); to Co. Rd. 225 (Stop and pickup); 208 to Co. Rd. 212; cross 72 and take 212 on Hwy. OO (New Era Bank Drive-In); to High School; Intermediate School; Garrett and Castle Gardens; Tiny Tots (Elementary Students); Kountry Kidds; Elementary School; Middle School

Bus #9 JimThompson Captain's Creek, Cedar Grove, Little Vine

Begin at 6:20 A.M. at O Hwy. and County Rd. 428 intersection; O to County Rd. 415 intersection; to E Hwy. and County Rd. 506 intersection; E at County Rd. 507; E to KK and 404 (Pickup and turn around); back to E; E to County Rd. 503; E at County Rd. 404; to Old Hwy. 67 to County Rd. 500 (Pickup and turn around); back to 67; to County Rd. 201 (Southwood); continue to Benson and Marshall; to Middle School; Elementary School; High School; Intermediate School

Bus #6 Carol Vest Silvermines Run

First pickup at 6:35 A.M at D Hwy. and County Rd. 535; turn around and head back east along D making regular stops (Except County Rd. 527); also stop at County Rd. 505 and D (County Rd. 527 students will be piked up at 505 and D); then to Hwy. 72; stop at 72 and County Rd. 521; then along 72 to County Rd. 504 to 503; back to 504; up to County Rd. 530 (turn around); back to 504 to 72 West to West Main; to Primary School; High School; Middle School; Intermediate School

Bus #2 Carl Stacy C Highway Run

First pickup at 6:30 A.M. at County Rd. 423 and CC; back to C Hwy. making regular stops; C and County Rd. 406; continue on C all the way to Old Hwy. 67; stop at Old Hwy. 67 and County Rd. 205; then to Primary School, High School, Middle School, Intermediate School

Bus #1 Lisa West Jewett Run

First pickup at 6:40 A.M. At County Rd. 424 and 437 to C Hwy.; back east all the way on C with stops at C and County Rd. 411 and EE and C and 411 (upper end); to County Rd. 401, to Elementary School, High School, Middle School, Intermediate School

Delayed Routes

On occasion, the R-1 School District may need to run delayed A.M. (morning) bus routes when road conditions at normal bus times are not favorable, but will improve within a few hours.

In such instances, the district's AUTOMATED CALLING SERVICE and the same radio and television stations that list cancellations would announce that there will be delayed bus routes that morning.

Should **inclement weather** make bus transportation hazardous, all schools will be closed. The Superintendent will make this decision. If school is closed or if school will run on either snow routes or delayed schedule, the announcement will be given by the AUTOMATED CALLING SERVICE and the following media: **Radio station KY-AM 1450, Radio station KTJJ-FM 98.5, television station KFVS-12, Radio station KFMO-AM 1240, radio Station Froggy 96.**

Patrons are asked not to phone the administrative offices to check on school closing. These phones are needed for notifications purposes at this time. Should a sports even or school activity be cancelled, notification will be given by the above-mentioned sources.
